Applications Due: Admission is considered rolling. However, applications will be clustered for interviews at the end

of October and of January, and as needed afterward.

Applying: A minimum GPA of 3.0 in last 60 hours is required (may provisionally consider lower). Prospective students apply to the non-thesis program online through the **Graduate School**. Additional items are submitted directly to the School of Education. Eligible applicants will be scheduled for an interview. The Elementary Education program offers two regular options and requires that applicants note their option at the time of application. Both options begin Summer II, lead to the same degree, and require the same coursework.

Completing the program in 12 months, instead of 10, does not delay your degree/license, nor does it prevent you from applying for jobs to begin in the upcoming fall.

- Option 1 is a full-time **twelve-month** program for students who need to complete EDCI 5554 (Exceptional Learners) and EDEP 5154 (Ed Psych for Teachers). These **must be** completed in Summer I prior to the start of the program in Summer II (or may be taken in Summer I after completing the program but will delay your application for licensure).
- Option 2 is a full-time **ten-month** program that begins in Summer II, and for students who have completed both EDCI 5554 and EDEP 5154. **Dual/Accelerated status is NOT required for this option.**

Prior Experience: Minimum of 100 documented hours in a supervised position working with 3-14 year-olds during the five years prior to applying. Parenting/Babysitting/Nannying does not count. Can be paid or volunteer hours. Documentation must be signed or initialed by the supervising authority. (Please include total hours on signature page for each documentation).

Endorsement Courses: Students who wish to obtain licensure eligibility for elementary education (prek-6) are expected to complete endorsement requirements prior to beginning the MAEd. Program. Courses in-progress or planned are acceptable at the time of application. Substitutions will be considered on a case by case basis and must cover similar content. A syllabus will be required for all non-VT substitutions and courses not listed in VT transcript. **This list is for students entering the MAEd. Program 2024 or later** VDOE (Virginia Department of Education)
