

II. Goals

- A. Counseling practice goals Please describe in detail the ways in which the following broad goals will be met.
 - School broadly Provides individual and group counseling and classroom guidance to promote the academic, career, and personal/social development of students.
 - Clinical Mental Health broadly Uses the principles and practices of diagnosis, treatment, referral, and prevention of mental and emotional disorders to initiate, maintain, and terminate counseling.

	3.	Group Counseling - The internship student will lead or co-lead at least one group with a minimum of four members for a series of sessions.

Depending on placement site, include the following where appropriate:

- 1. <u>Classroom Guidance</u> For internship students in elementary, middle, and secondary schools, there will be opportunities for participation in classroom guidance using materials and activities appropriate for the setting.
- 2. <u>Consultation</u> The internship student will complete at least two consultation sessions during the internship period.
- 3. <u>Testing/Assessment</u> The internship student will participate in the administration and interpretation (either individually or in a group) of the results of at least two different tests.
- 4. <u>Referrals</u> The internship student will participate in the process of referring clients or observe at least two referrals to other community agencies or other services within the school or agency.
- 5. <u>Training and Development</u> The internship student will help to develop and conduct at least two structured educational experiences for either students, clients, teachers, parents, or other agency staff. The student should either lead or co-lead these experiences.
