Free Electives can be whatever you wish pending that you meet all pre-reqs etc. to take the course. You can also replace free electives with double major or minor credits.

- You do NOT need to follow this plan exactly. This is a SUGGESTED plan.
- Your Pathways, Major Electives and Free electives can be moved around to suit your needs and/or the option you choose.
- This example assumes that a student is entering VT with NO additional credit and is starting fresh with everything INCLUDING foreign language.
- This plan is based on 15 credit (cr) hours a semester.
- 4 Year plans will vary for each student based on the following factors: AP credit, Transfer Credit, Dual Enrollment Credit, Advanced Standing, summer/winter courses, or Major Option.
