## Information to give your French advisor:

1) How many years of French you took in high school and the grades you earned;

2) Any AP or IB Diploma exam scores you got from high school (VT does not give credit for the IB certificate, only the IB diploma);

- 3) Any French classes you took at other colleges and the grades you earned;
- 4) Any French classes you have already taken at VT;
- 5) How long it has been since you took a French class;

6) Any extended live-abroad experience you have had in a French-speaking country;

7) Whether French is going to be your major, your minor, the language for your International Studies major, or an elective;

8) What semester you plan to graduate;

9) Your student number.

## How to declare a minor or major in the French program:

• Please note that majors and minors receive priority for force-adds to French courses. It is in your interest to declare the minor or major sooner rather than later.

- If you would like to declare French as a primary major, you may do so via Hokie Spa and the Hokie.COMM link during the prescribed dates. Outside of those official change-of-major dates and as long as you are already a student in CLAHS, you may contact Dr. Kimbrell (<u>mkimbrel@vt.edu</u>) in the Dean's office, who will assist you in adding French as your primary major.
- If you are interested in declaring French as a secondary major or of declaring one of the French minors (French, French for Business, or the Language and Culture for the Practice of Science Pathways Minor), please fill out a form that is available at <a href="https://liberalarts.vt.edu/forms.html">https://liberalarts.vt.edu/forms.html</a> (Click on "Change of Primary Major, Second Major and/or Minors" and then click on "Request to Change Second Major or Minor form"). Within a couple of weeks of completing the form, you should receive an email telling you who your French advisor is.
